KCJ HF contest held in Aug. had about 900 participants and we received 405 logs (56.8 % of logs were sent through e-mail). Participants decreased by 10 % compared with those of last year but logs submitted are almost the same as those of last year. Even though the rate of log submission seems low, we could crosscheck 82 % of whole contacts.

Precations for next time are follows:

- 1) Please log DX callsigns as they sent. Some logs contain such as JA1DD/KH2 though he identified KH2/JA1DD. This is treated as you had a wrong callsign.
- 2) Please send accurate check-logs with no points and no multi described. Check-logs naturally are not for your points but important for others you worked in the cross-checking system of KCJ contest. (We type in data of paper logs, so neat logs are welcome, by the way.)
