Reminiscence of Akihabara Part 2

Thank you for the articles in NEWSLETTER No. 39 about the reminiscence of Akihabara. I enjoyed them. Being triggered by them and remembering my radio child days, I built a Germanium (Ge) X-tal radio. I bought a kit by mail order because I threw out my junk such as variable capacitors (VCs), coils which I had been keeping

till a few years ago. This radio consists of two VCs, coils and Ge diodes. It has a double-tuned voltage-doubling detect circuit. As I don't have good antenna for receiving broadcast (BC), a usual detect circuit was not enough to hear it loud but voltage-doubling detect circuit was good. Photo shows, in addition of Ge radio (right), a key and a CW rig, QRPp TRCV which consists of two

transistors. I used this as a practice of Japanese morse code. It's QRP but actually transmitted radio wave, so I was satisfied as a radio operator and technician. I am now collecting parts for a two vacuum tube TX and a five tube super-heterodyne receiver.

3. Mode : CW.
4. Categories Participants in Japan(JA): Single Operator - Multi-band and Single band, Multi Operator and SWL - Multi-band.
Those in overseas(DX) and SWL: Multi-band.
5. Bands : 1.8 through 50Mhz, except WARC bands.
Suggested frequencies :
1810-1825kHz, 3510-3525kHz, 7010-7030kHz, 14050-14080kHz,
21050-21080kHz, 28050-28080kHz, 50.050-50.090MHz
6. Exchange JA : RST plus Prefecture/district code. DX : RST plus Continent code (See the reference of this document).
7. Invalid contacts:
 - a. On cross-mode or not CW.
 - b. By cross-band, via repeater or satellite.
8. Points : For each complete contact on each band,
JA : One point with JA, five points with DX.
DX : One point with JA, no point with others.
10. Multipliers : Each prefecture/district (and continent for JA) worked on each band.
