KCJ is a member of ICWC, International CW Council. ICWC officially announced a weekly “MST Contest.” This new contest will start on May 2, 2022 (Monday).

The ICWC is pleased to sponsor a contest called the MST (Medium Speed Test) to help populate the CW bands with activity on Mondays and Tuesdays at the speed of 20-25wpm. The more activity heard on the CW bands the better chances we have to preserve them. The speed was chosen to appeal to more operators. We look forward to participation worldwide, especially among all the Council member organizations.

04 Tokyo 10 On-Air Monthly Event

【JH1ASG/NAKA】

As a member of JARL Tokyo Branch, I arranged The Tokyo 10 On-Air Monthly event again this year. With the great support of JA8AJE/MASA and JI3DST/TAKE, KCJ took part in the event for the first time. I would like to give you the outline.

1. Tokyo 10 On-Air Monthly Event

According to KCJ, Tokyo, the capital of Japan's prefecture code is "TK" at KCJ Contest. On the other hand, JARL, Japan Amateur Radio League stipulate Tokyo's regional code as "10." Therefore, in connection with this number 10, JARL Tokyo Branch called on its registered member clubs, including KCJ to make OCTOBER the PR month and started this project in 2019.

JARL Tokyo Branch prepared the common QSL Card and provided its registered clubs with the card based on the activities in October.

2. Common QSL Card



An object of the Olympic Mark, New Tokyo National Stadium were printed on the card. Moreover, the contrail of Blue Impulse of Japan's Air Self-Defense Force was shown. I took this picture on the very first day of Tokyo 2020 competitions, ahead of the Opening Ceremony.

I showed "Host City of Olympic and Paralympic Games Tokyo 2020" in Japanese.

The data side is blank, and the contents such as club name and club call, etc. are left to each registered club.

3. Clubs participated in the event

This time, 17 clubs including KCJ and JARL Tokyo Branch participated in the event, and in October 2021, the required number of QSL cards based on the number of QSOs by each club was 8,300 in total. (One of the clubs issued its own QSL card.)

Since the number was 4,900 in 2019 and 4,900 in 2020, the number of common QSL cards prepared by JARL Tokyo Branch has increased dramatically, the highest ever. The number of participated clubs also doubled from last year to 10⇒8⇒17.

We would like to thank KCJ and other participated clubs for taking part in this successful event.

4. My hope for our future

Although it was amid the COVID-19 disaster, it is an undeniable fact that the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games were held mainly in Tokyo in 2021.

We will continue to hold this event and issue the common QSL card to pass on the legacy of the Games, that is, to pass on Tokyo, the host city of the 1964/2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games, to future generations.
