


1. JARL Tokyo Branch CW Contest 2024

KCJ is a registered club of Japan Amateur Radio League (JARL) Tokyo Branch.

In October 2024, KCJ members participated in the Tokyo CW Contest sponsored by JARL Tokyo Branch and won the first place in the club competition. The mode for this contest is CW only, and the frequency is 3.5-430MHz. The score is 1 point for 1 QSO, and 2 points for QSO with an amateur station in Tokyo.

As a result of adding up the scores of KCJ members nationwide, KCJ came in the 1st place out of 33 clubs that entered. The JARL Tokyo Branch Conference will be held in April 2025, and I am to attend the award ceremony on behalf of the club on the stage.

The below is my picture after the award ceremony last year. At that time, KCJ got the 3rd place in the club competition at the same contest in 2024. I am looking forward to this year's award ceremony in April, 2025 in Tokyo.



2. JARL Tokyo Branch UHF Contest 2024

In November 2024, I participated in the JARL Tokyo Branch UHF Contest and got the 2nd place. The category was JA1 Area (Kanto), Outside Tokyo Area, CW & Phone, and All Bands.

Since I transmitted only two bands, namely 430 MHz and 1200 MHz by ICOM IC-9700, and I don't have ICOM IC-905 which can transmit above 2400MHz, I didn't expect to achieve good results.

Together with the award for KCJ, I will attend the JARL Tokyo Branch Conference in April to receive my certificate.

3. JARL Field Day Contest 2024

I won the area leader of Shinetsu (Niigata and Nagano) held in August 2024 and received a certificate signed by President Morita, President of JARL.



The maximum output for this contest is 50 Watts, and if one participates using a temporary antenna and a portable power source, he/she can double the total score. A major feature of this contest is that many Japanese amateur radio operators go outside of their shacks to take part in this contest. I might call it "a summer tradition."

Recently, summers in Japan have extremely high temperatures and humidity, making it necessary to pay very close attention to health management. For this reason, mobile operation outdoors is really difficult, but I am glad I participated in the 2024 FD Contest.
